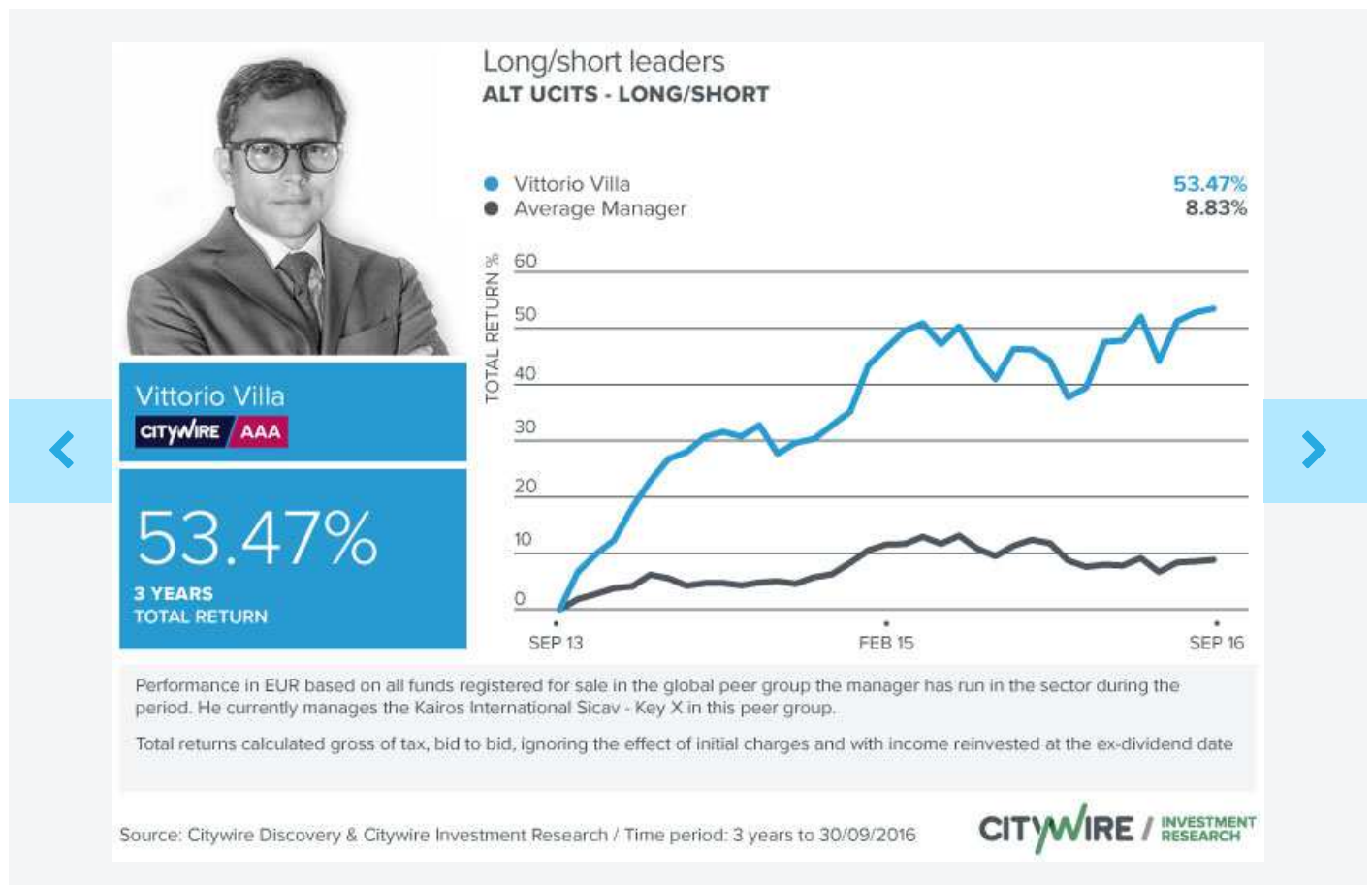


The best long/short equity managers of the past three years

Citywire AAA-rated Vittorio Villa takes third spot in this rundown for his work on the Kairos International Sicav – Key X fund, which he has managed since its launch in mid-2013. This is the only fund he currently oversees at Italian investment group Kairos.

Speaking to *Citywire Selector* earlier in the year, Villa said he had achieved success in his investments into [lottery concessions](#) – which he said investors were overlooking despite good turnover and cash flow. In addition, he said he was looking at train operator Eurotunnel as a potentially strong [post-Brexit investment](#).

The fund operates with a concentration on the European equity market. Villa primarily invests in infrastructure assets, while targeting equities with bond-like qualities and returns.
